How we plan to use our EYFS Pupil Premium funding this year -

Number of pupils eligible for EYFS PP Pupil Premium funding:

9 = £858.60

£858 x 3 = £2,575.80

This is a plan for the academic year 2016 - 2017.

Please note that the number of children in receipt of EYFS Pupil Premium changes from term to term as some children become eligible, and other children come to or leave the school.

We use our EYFS Pupil Premium funding in a variety of ways, to support the academic achievement of, and increase opportunities for, all EYFS Pupil Premium children, and also to address individual needs which may disadvantage a EYFS Pupil Premium child personally, socially or emotionally. We will upskill a TA in speaking and listening activities with an outside, gardening focus, and continue to develop hands-on, experiential learning which we know engages our PP children particularly in EYFS, in speaking, listening, planning, discovery and writing for a purpose. We hope to purchase a greenhouse during the academic year so that we have all-year-round opportunities for planting and growing.

EYFS Pupil Premium funding to be allocated in the following ways:

Total:

Per year in total for 9 children if 9 is a consistent figure

School focus: continuing to develop experiential learning opportunities.

TA L2 subsidy for dedicated gardening hours per week: three terms

Greenhouse resources - compost, pots etc.

Consultancy costs (RHS gardener) reduced by involvement in gardening, learning network.

By developing 'all year gardening' with dedicated gardener-TA time, and use of a new greenhouse (primarily funded from capital), we will provide greater opportunities for our EYFS PP children to experience hands-on planting and growing, speech and language development, science opportunities and environmental awareness (recycling etc.), after school
