How we plan to use our Pupil Premium funding this year

It is important to remember that Pupil Premium funding is paid to schools quarterly and follows the financial year from April to April, but schools follow an academic year of three terms from September to July.
This is a plan for the academic year 2020 – 2021.

Please note that the number of children in receipt of Pupil Premium changes from term to term as some children become eligible, and other children come to or leave the school.

We use our Pupil Premium funding in a variety of ways, to support the academic achievement of, and increase opportunities for, all Pupil Premium children, and also to address individual needs which may disadvantage a Pupil Premium child personally, socially or emotionally. Good to outstanding teaching makes the most impact on pupil achievement, and we use our Pupil Premium funding to increase the direct teaching hours spent with our PP children. Although we are a small school, we employ two HLTAs. In 2020-2021, we will continue to fund additional HLTA hours.

Pupil Premium funding to be allocated in the following ways:
