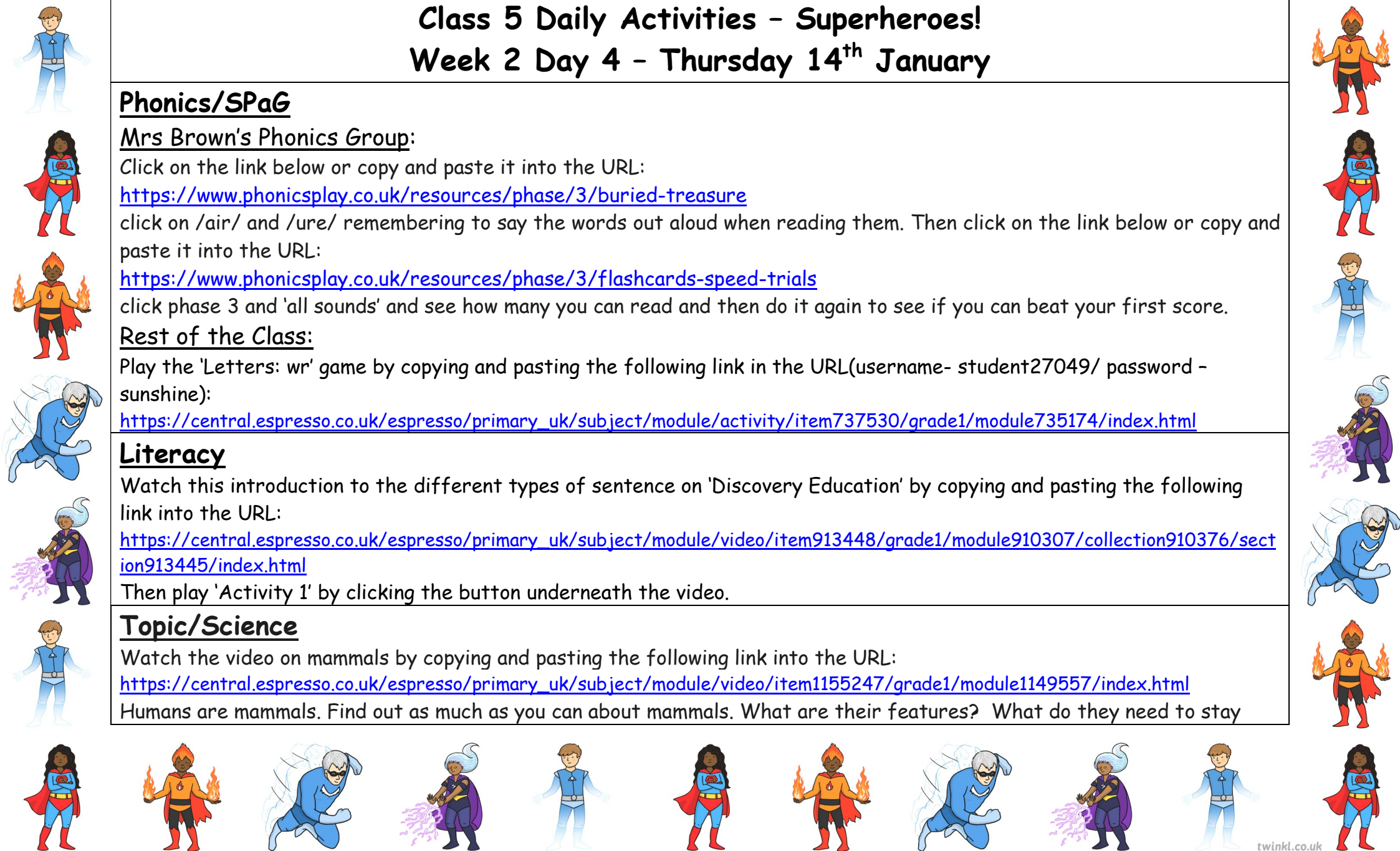
Then play 'Activity 1' by clicking the button underneath the video.
