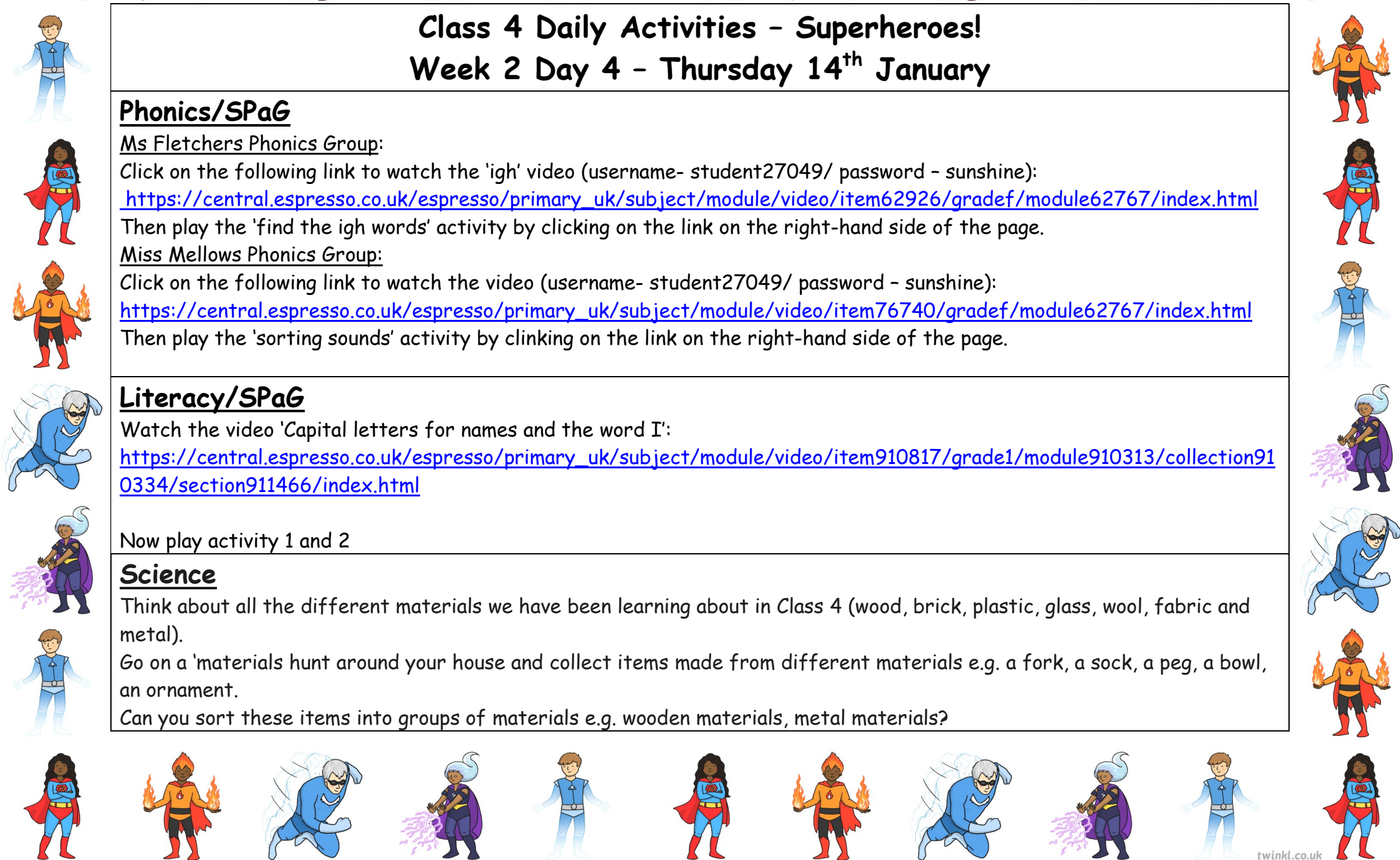
Now play activity 1 and 2
